Ishihara brothers found Ishihara Bros. Industries (Nishinari-ku, Osaka City)

Starts manufacture and sales of forging machinery

1944 昭和19年

Fuji Zoki Co., Ltd. is founded, and establishes the headquarters and Osaka Plant in Sayama-cho (now Osakasayama City, Minamikawachi-gun, Osaka Prefecture Starts manufacture and sales of forging machinery, cast iron, and iron and steel products of monator Shihara becomes the company's first president

1945 昭和20年

Changes the company name to Fuji Car Manufacturing Co., Ltd. Starts manufacture and sales of railway vehicles

1948 昭和23年

Opens the Namba office in Osaka City

1951 昭和26年

* Delivers 32mm x 11m ship frame bender (Japan's largest at the time)

1952 昭和27年

Lists on the Osaka Securities Exchange Opens the Tokyo office

1953 昭和28年

Opens office in Bangkok, Thailand
* Receives order for the construction of three bridges in Thailand, including a bascule bridge over the Menam River

1954 昭和29年

Starts manufacture and sales of bridges, steel beams, and steel towers Lists on the Tokyo Stock Exchange

1955 昭和30年

Relocates the Osaka office (former Namba office to the Sanshinkan Building on Midosuji, Osaka * Starts manufacture and sales of first domestic LPG tanker trucks

1956 昭和31年

Opens a technician training school

1957 昭和32年

* Starts manufacture and sales of high-pressure containers and chemical machinery and equipment

1959 昭和34年

Establishes Fuji Sales Co., Ltd.

1960 昭和35年

* Receives order for the construction of a bridge across the Torle Sap River in Cambodia Spins off the cleaning machine division (cleaning devices, yarn knitting machines, driving anchors) and establishes Fujiselik (Co., Ltd.

1961 昭和36年

Lists on the Nagoya Stock Exchange Establishes Fuji Yuso Co., Ltd.

1962 昭和37年

Establishes the Fuji Car Manufacturing Health Insurance Society * Constructs first domestic mechanical parking garage

Holds groundbreaking ceremony for the Shiga Plant

1963 昭和38年

Builds the Shiga Plant in Moriyama Town, Shiga Prefecture (now Moriyama City) and relocates the production division for vehicles and bridges to it "Forges technical partnership with KUKA of West Germany and starts manufacture and sales of various public hygiene vehicles "Completes first rotary loader"
